This client required a Project Management course that would show the do's and don'ts along with a methodology which could be applied to all types of projects.

Project Details

Duration **EPICWay® to Manage Projects** two day training workshop.

One day a week for two weeks.

Objectives Agnition customised this course specifically for the client to fulfil the training needs for all participants. The training was to be designed so that the attendees would have not only an adaptable approach to projects in the future but they would also improve their overall ability as project managers.

Deliverables The first stage of this training programme was an introduction to Agnition's unique approach - **EPICWay®** - What it is, how it works and why it works. This stage also explained the **Project Charter**, how it works and why it is so important.

Participants brought their own project and work with them to develop their own project. This meant that each attendee could apply the classroom learning to their workplace.

At the end of the two day training programme, each attendee handed in a copy of their completed **Project Charter** along with their own analysis of what they had learned. This was graded by the trainer and each person received FETAC Level 6 accreditation for the course.
